Dear Ms. Guthrie:

The Texas Water Code, Section 36.108, Subsection (o), states that the Texas Water Development Board’s executive administrator shall provide each district and regional water planning group located wholly or partly within a groundwater management area with the managed available groundwater (MAG) in the management area based upon the desired future condition(s) of the groundwater resource. This letter and the attached reports (GAM Run 09-026 MAG, GAM Run 10-019 MAG, and GAM Run 10-020 MAG) are in response to this directive.

As noted in the letter received by the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) on July 30, 2009, from Kyle Ingham of the Panhandle Regional Planning Commission on behalf of Groundwater Management Area 1, desired future conditions were adopted for the Ogallala Aquifer on July 7, 2009. In a letter received by TWDB on June 14, 2010, Mr. Ingham noted that desired future conditions were adopted for the Dockum and Blaine aquifers on June 3, 2010.

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We encourage open communication and coordination between groundwater conservation districts, regional water planning groups, and the TWDB to ensure that the total pumping and managed available groundwater reported in regional water plans and groundwater management plans are not in conflict. We estimated total pumping and managed available groundwater using the best available scientific tools. However, these estimates are based on assumptions of the magnitude and distribution of pumping in the aquifer. It is therefore important for groundwater conservation districts to monitor whether their management of pumping is achieving their desired future conditions. Districts are encouraged to continue to work with the TWDB to better define available groundwater as additional information may help better assess responses of the aquifer to pumping and its distribution now and in the future.
